## Prepare with confidence using the social risk assessment

The Social Risk Assessment (SRA) on the [amfori Sustainability Platform](#) is your first step toward proactive risk management. By completing this simple questionnaire, you can **identify potential social risks early**, prepare effectively for your next amfori BSCI audit, and lay the foundation for continuous improvement.

## Why this matters?

Comply with risk-based due diligence programmes

Detect risks early and improve audit efficiency

Build transparency and trust with stakeholders

## Step-by-step approach

### STEP 1 Access the feature



- Log-in to the amfori Sustainability Platform
- Go to "My Risk Assessment" > "Ongoing"

### STEP 2 Update site details



- Select the production site you wish to assess and update its information

### STEP 3 Complete the questionnaire



- Answer between 60-90 straightforward questions (mostly yes/no)
- Pause and resume at any time within three months

### STEP 4 Submit and receive your SRA results



- Click "Submit" to finish the questionnaire
- View your risk indicators under "My Risk Assessment" > "Results"

### STEP 5 Prepare for your next amfori BSCI audit and beyond



- Use your SRA results to focus your audit preparation (guides, training sessions on the [amfori Academy](#) etc.)
- Review your internal policies and gather relevant documentation
- Consult [the amfori BSCI System Manual part 4 amfori BSCI Guidelines for business partners](#), for final checks
- Plan for continuous improvement after the audit



**TIP: Completing the SRA before your amfori BSCI audit ensures better preparation and more accurate audit results.**

## Questions

### What is a potential risk?

A situation at your site where a social compliance issue could occur if not managed.

### Why complete the SRA before an amfori BSCI audit?

Currently it is optional, but strongly recommended. It helps you identify risks early, align with due diligence and strengthen your business relationship with amfori members.

### Is it mandatory or costly? Who can see the results?

No. It is included in the amfori membership. All amfori members sourcing from you can view the results.

### Who should complete it and how long does it take?

Qualified staff at the production site. About two hours, with the option to pause and resume within three months. You can attach supporting documents such as your business licence, certificates etc.

### Can I redo the risk assessment if I make a mistake?

Yes, as often as needed.
